MITES (2009) \$500

The Jr. Cyclones Mite program is for those looking to start organized hockey in the 8 and under age group (8U). The Mites will participate in age appropriate practices that will emphasize the key fundamental aspects to the game of hockey, all while trying to keep a fun and enjoyable environment to ensure smiles and stories every time the player leaves the ice.

PEEWEE (2005/2006)

\$600

The Jr. Cyclones Pee wee program is for those looking to start organized hockey in the 12 and under age group (12U). The Pee wees will review the rules of full ice 5-on-5 play, such as penalties, offsides, and icings. Pee wee practices will begin to shift focus on team work, while continuing to work on the basic fundamentals needed to improve their personal games.

SQUIRTS (2007/2008)

\$600

The Jr. Cyclones Squirt program is for those looking to start organized hockey in the 10 and under age group (10U). The Squirts will be introduced to the full ice game of hockey, graduation from the half ice game they learned while playing Mites. Here they will be taught the new rules of icing, and offsides, as well as new skill sets building each skater's abilities. The very basics of 5-on-5 team play will also be incorporated into the practices and games.

BANTAM/MIDGET (2001-2004) \$600

The Jr. Cyclones Bantam/Midget program is for those looking to start organized hockey in the 15 and under age group (15U). The Bantams will review the rules of full ice 5-on-5 play, such as penalties, offsides, and icings. Bantam practices will continue to shift focus on team work, while still working on the basic fundamentals needed to improve their personal games.
